

Who AND Where IS THE SHIRE OF **CARNARVON?**

The Shire of Carnarvon is proudly situated on Yinggarda (Carnarvon) and Baiyungu (Coral Bay) country.

The Shire of Carnarvon is the heartbeat between the two World Heritage Areas of Shark Bay and the Ningaloo Reef. Carnarvon is the main business district of the Shire, with Coral Bay our world renown tourist destination.

The Shire of Carnarvon extends from the southern boundaries of Yaringa and Meedo Stations, to the northern boundaries of Cardabia and Marrilla Stations, and east to the Kennedy Ranges and Mardathuna Station. Encompassing 28 pastoral stations, 180 plantations and has a total population of approximately 6,500 people (2021 Census).

The town of Carnaryon is located approximately 895km north of Perth along the Indian Ocean coastline and Coral Bay is 238km north from the Carnarvon CBD.
