For Yinggarda people, the stars are part of a living cultural landscape, guiding seasonal movement, sharing moral lessons, and holding stories that connect people to land, sea, and sky. As you look upward, ancient Dreaming stories of the constellations reveal how the night sky has long been shared. Through guided stargazing and telescope viewing, distant planets, nebulae, and galaxies come into focus. Yet the true power of the experience lies in the intersection between an ancient cultural interpretation and modern space science.

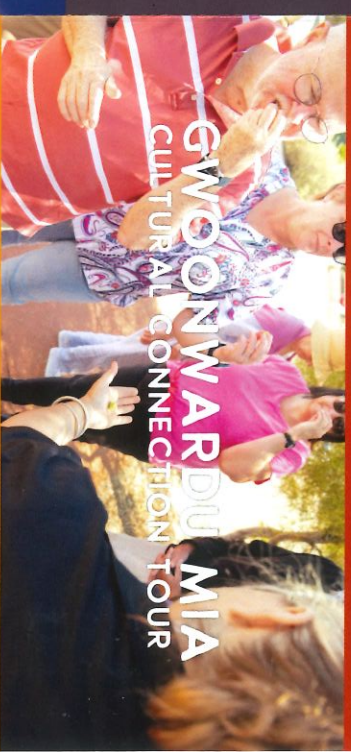


Burrowing Bees

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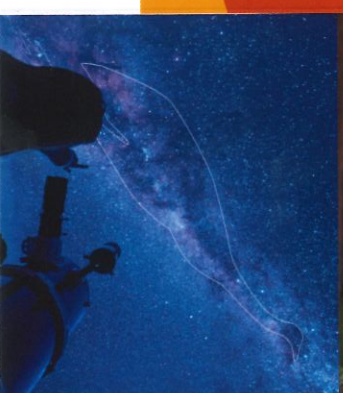
